Check it out.

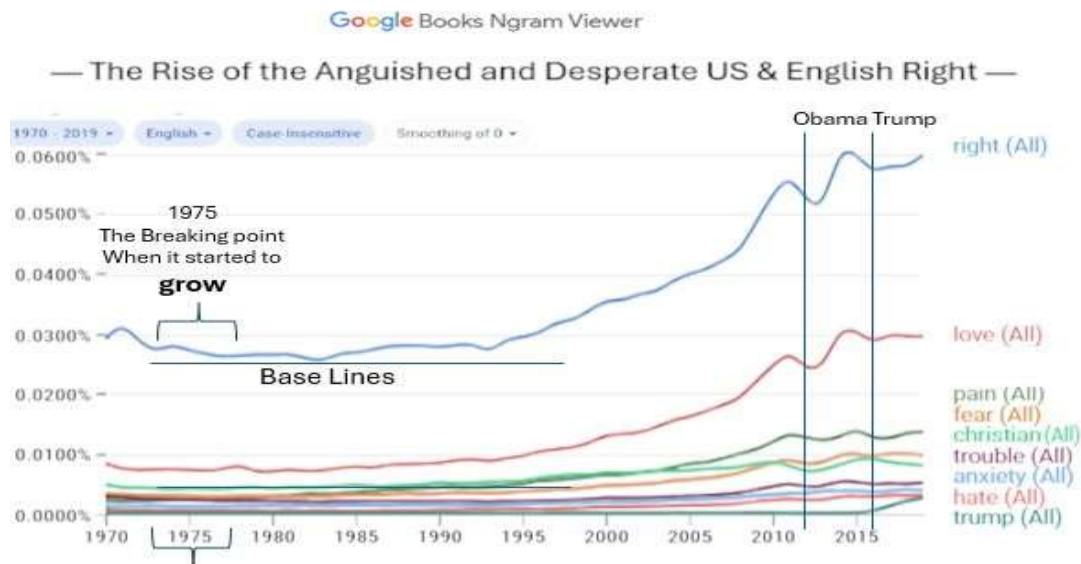


Fig 1 & 2 - The emergence of the Christian nationalism cult that Trump became the charismatic leader of in 2015 and called out in 2020 to attack the capital. The figure shows the frequency of these motivating purpose and grievance terms 2070 to 2019
