

Ethanol and Milk Price History - An apparent collision.


I. Intro


- A. This is a raw research document, text data and prelim graph pages
- B. A search on the NY Times web site for articles and blogs containing Ethanol+Milk+Price produce the following tables of 70 blog entries and 21 articles. The links take you to the text on the Times site. The dates were copied to EthMilkPr.xls and the article frequencies graphed, showing sharp spikes in April 2007 in articles and spikes in the blog entries two months later in June and then in Jan 2008. The corn and milk prices published for Illinois from 1960 were then graphed and added
- C. The 'hypothesis' being considered is that the expectation that large and continually increasing amounts of productive land would be available for biofuels without a reaction from their present users, and that crossed one of those 'invisible' lines and triggered a price war.

Monthly Illinois State Milk and Corn Prices from 1960 to 2008







A significant increase in corn price volatility developed in the early 1970's and milk price volatility the early 1990's. That volatility disguises the take-off point of the simultaneous price explosion that becomes visible in 2007. We might call this the global warming effect, as it seems primarily resulting from the reaction of milk prices to increasing demand for productive land for agricultural bio-fuels, though that is not demonstrated by just the visible coupling.


From a chart of historical data like this there is no good way to tell if the peaks of 2008 will reverse like the corn price peak of 1997. To know whether the present trend is reversible or not you need to know what is physically shifting, and whether the increased demand for corn, and rising price for milk apparently to block corn's take-over, is cyclic or permanent.





	The interesting thing is that there are two distinct spikes in the blog postings, June 13, 2007 and Jan 13, 2008, with only a low level trickle of interest before. The earliest indication there might be a conflict between established land uses and ever expanding conversion of land for energy production was articles only two days apart on April 20 & 22 of 2007. so, for the "chattering classes", these kinds of majestically colliding evolutionary forces seem to come as a) a big surprise and b) a passing fancy.
